Rules and regulations

1. All applicants will have to take an admission test, after which the admission will be processed.
2. All successful applications will be on a three month trial basis.
3. Students applying to Hifz Class must be at least 10 years of age, and students applying for FE class must be at least 12 years of age.
4. All students must apply to Islamic teachings including dress.
5. The timings of the Madrasah will be decided only by the principal. All students will be expected to respect the times set by the Madrasah
6. In case of absence, the student must present a written excuse from his parent or guardian on the next day of class to the principal before attending class. Also students arriving late or wishing to leave early must have a written excuse from the parent.
7. Parents are expected to schedule weekends and holidays in such a manner that students do not miss class.
8. Parents are expected to ensure that students prepare their lesson before class. It is recommended for students in Hifz class that they spend at least half an hour at night and one hour in the morning. Students in FE class should spend at least half an hour daily in lesson preparation.
9. The Madrasah has the full right to dismiss any student where it seems necessary and he will have no legal remedy against the Madrasah.
10. In case of complaint or any matter, one should consult the head teacher either verbally or by writing.
11. In case of change of address or phone number, one should immediately notify the Madrasah. If one fails to do so the Madrasah will not be responsible for any occurrences in correspondences or emergencies.
12. If a student does not sit the final year exam, he may be removed from the Madrasah register or he may have to repeat the year.
